Program Spotlight: Yak & Pack Adventure Trip

Wilderness Adventure Trips are offered for 11-17 year olds and include backpacking, canoeing, and kayaking trips to some of the most beautiful areas in the upper Midwest. One of our newer trips, the Yak & Pack, combines the best of 2 worlds and has received rave reviews since it first began in 2006. The Yak & Pack trip is offered for campers ages 13-15. Along with their adventure trip counselors, they spend their first day at camp getting to know one another and planning and preparing for their trip. On the second day, they depart camp for beautiful Bayfield, Wisconsin on the shores of Lake Superior where they camp out for the evening. It is early to rise on day 3 as they make their way to our outfitters for a morning of kayaking safety and instruction before heading out for 3 days and 2 nights exploring the waters, caves, and historical history of the Apostle Islands area of Lake Superior. Upon their return to shore, they drive up to the Porcupine Mountains of Michigan's Upper Peninsula for the second half of this dream trip. There, campers spend 2 nights hiking and exploring the gorgeous hills, waterfalls, streams, and Lake Superior shorelines of the Porkies. Space is limited on this amazing trip and it is only offered twice for the summer of 2008! We hope to see you on the Yak & Pack next summer.
